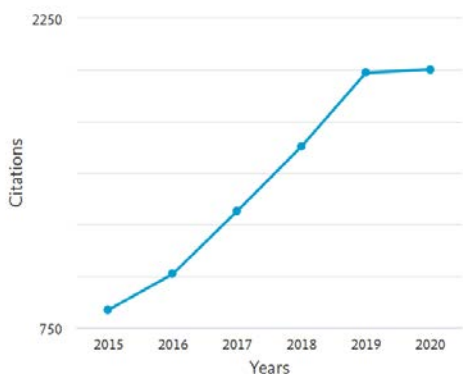

Some accomplishments and our progress so far are:



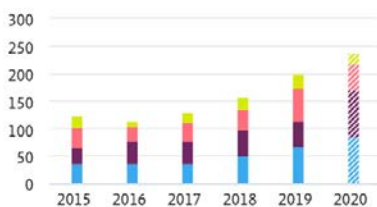

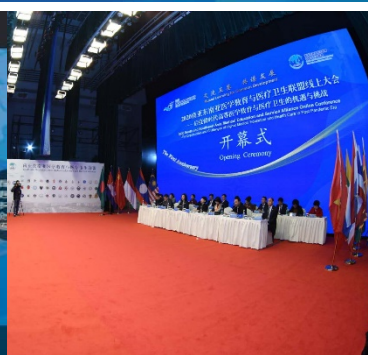

She was working as a contract lecturer and later an Associate Professor at the Department of Parasitology, Faculty of Medicine, University of Malaya, Malaysia for almost two decades (from 1999 to 2017). She is now working as an Associate Professor at the School of Allied Health Sciences, Walailak University, Thailand. Dr Veeranoot is actively involved in her research areas of interest: 1). Infectious parasitic diseases includes epidemiology and clinical relevant, 2). Diagnostic challenges, 3). Natural products, 4). Water-based research, and 5). Health awareness on both anthropologic and zoonotic aspects. Dr Veeranoot is a coordinator of international research networks (IRN); Southeast Asia Water Team (SEA Water Team) and World Union for Herbal Drug Discovery (WUHeDD). She has published of more than 100 papers including book chapters and is an editorial board member of reputable journals as well as an active reviewer of more than 50 international journals. She also serves as the Editor (Guest, Academic and Associate), Speaker, Adjunct faculty as well as Visiting. She is the recipient of an outstanding Dr Matthew A. Eichler "Research Fellow Award" from Asia Pacific Consortium for Researchers and Educators (APCORE) at Guam, USA, 2018.
