

Announcement of Walailak University on COVID-19 No.2

Walailak University would like to take the following measures in the interest of the safety of all staff and students:

1. Walailak University will not allow or approve any staff or student to travel to provinces deemed as maximum control zones as prescribed by Department of Disease Control of Thailand.

If travel to such maximum control zones is necessary, the person must declare themselves by fill in the information at the following website when returning to university

and a 14-day quarantine will be enforced either in a place arranged by the University or at home. The quarantine period will not be deemed as leave and therefore, supervisors must assign appropriate work from home and online study for the employee and student respectively.

2. After register in the link, the person must get screened for COVID-19 infection at WU hospital. If it falls into the prevention of disease surveillance or a doctor diagnoses as suspected COVID-19 disease, the person must report to respective supervisor or lecturer who will consult their respective vice-presidents for approval. A 14-day quarantine will be enforced either in a place arranged by the University or at home. The quarantine period will not be deemed as leave and therefore, supervisors must assign appropriate work from home and online study for the employee and student respectively.

3. Shorten the teaching and learning schedule by arrange the class on Saturday and Sunday and all class must be finish on 19 Jan 2021

4. The dean must consider together with relevant organization for the community-based teaching and learning, professional practice, field practice and co-operative education for students.
