



3. Confirm registration

The registration will not take effect if students have not confirmed their enrollment. You can do this by clicking on the menu "Confirm registration" from the screen on the left-hand side. Then the system will display the results of registration and the schedule for the cours that students have chosen. Student must press the "Confirm registration" button after review the results.



4. Late Registration


FRESHY students have two dresses depending on the situation.

 - Navy blue skirt, 1 inch below the knee.
 - University brooch on the left chest.
 - Black leather high heels not more than 3 inches.
 - 1.3 Islamic women's ceremonial dress
 - White shirt with long sleeves and no pattern.
 - Long sleeveless black skirt.
 - A university clasp and brooch on tahe left chest.
 - Black leather high heels not more than 3 inches.
- 2. Student uniform for new students or FRESHY.
 - 2.1 FRESHY Men
 - Long sleeved shirt with no pattern.
 - Navy blue trousers.
 - Black leather University belt.
 - Black leather shoes with socks.
 - 2.2 FRESHY Women
 - Short-sleeved white shirt with no pattern. The shirt should be modest and tucked into the skirt.
 - University brooch on the left chest.
 - Black skirt, 1 inch below the knee.
 - Black leather University belt.
 - White heeled shoes not exceeding 1inch and no white socks.
 - 2.3 FRESHY Islamic women's dress
 - White shirt with long sleeves and no pattern.

Accommodation

Please note: The stated costs are a guide only, while they were accurate at the time of printing they are subject change.

Student Accommodation Dormitory

The University manages 17 dormitories: 13 for female students and 4 for male students. The dormitory provide on campus accommodation for 6,140 students. Each hall of residence contains 2-bed, 3-bed or 4-bedrooms, a computer room, a study room, a reading room, prayer rooms for students of the Buddhist or Islamic faith, a television room, and a recreational room. Facilities and services for residents include a halls of residence office, a minimart, a beauty and hairdressing salon, a bookshop, laundry service, cafeterias, a night food center, and banking and postal services.

Students can choose to live on campus in the dormitories or off in private apartments. First year students are encouraged to live on campus until they are fully integrated into university life.

The University arranges student dormitories as a learning, living and caring community (Living, Learning and Caring Center). The following services and benefits are provided in each dormitory:

- 1. Dormitory managers can be contacted 24 hours a day.
- 2. A 24-hour security guard.
- 3. A cleaner to clean the common area of the dormitory.
- 4. Comfortable, clean and safe rooms. There are central activity rooms, computer rooms with wireless internet, function room, ironing room and TV room.
- 5. Home medicine services are available with first aid facilities and the ambulance service is 24 hours.
- 6. Hot and cold water services.
- 7. A public telephone in the dorm.
- 8. Activities for enhancing the quality of life.
- 9. Dormitory coordinator center.
- 10. ATM machine at Thaiburi building, student activity building, lecturers building 5 and Cho Pradu food center.
- 11. Indoor and outdoor sports center such as football, basketball, tennis and swimming pool.
- 12. Canteens throughout day and night.
- 13. WU Book center, supermarket, and laundry shop.
- 14. Convenience store.
- 15. Night market on Monday and Thursday.

The University emphasizes making dorm life a Living, Learning and Caring Centre to support the accommodation environment so that students develop responsibility, respect each other rights, and learn to live in the community, have a responsibility in the community and live a happy life in the university.



Center for International Affairs (CIA) Services

International students require a Non-Immigrant Education Visa (Category "ED") to study in Thailand. Whenever possible, applicants should apply for their student visa well in advance of departing for Thailand. Applications should be made in person at the Royal Thai Embassy or Consulate-General in their home country. Please carefully read "Visa and Immigration for International Students".



The 24 Hours Report (Notification of residence of foreigners)

According to section 38 of the 1979 immigration act, "House owners, heads of household, landlords or managers of hotels who accommodate foreign nationals on a temporary basis who stay in the kingdom legally, must notify the local immigration authorities within 24 hours from the time of arrival of the foreign national."

- 1. International students arriving at Walailak University must contact the school who will take you to the CIA office. For 24 hours report, please prepare your Passport and TM.6 (arrival card).
- 2. CIA will copy your document then CIA will do the 24 hours report via internet.
- 3. CIA will give the copy / print the 24 hours report for students.

Note: If you arrived at Walailak University on Friday (night) or Saturday-Sunday, please contact the school immediately and take a picture of your passport following:

- First page, the page is all your information such as your name-surname, Passport number, expiry date of the passport etc.



- The page that has your Education visa sticker from the Thai Embassy or Thai Consulate.



- The page that shows the immigration arrival stamp when you first arrived in Thailand.



- The small white paper we call "TM.6 or the Departure card."



Note:

- The notification of staying in the Kingdom over 90 days is in no way equivalent to a visa extension.
- Iff a foreigner staying in the kingdom over 90 days without notifying the Immigration Bureau or notifying the Immigration Bureau later than the set period, a fine of 2,000.- Baht will be collected. If a foreigner who did not make the notification of staying over 90 days is arrested, he will be fined 4,000.- Baht.
- If a foreigner leaves the country and re-enters, the day count starts at 1 in every case.



Student Accident Insurance – The University provides accident insurance for students. All accident cases are covered throughout the school year. Themedical expenses are 12,000 Baht per accident and 120,000 baht in the case of death. Cremation fees of 10,000 Baht are also provided.

When students have an accident, they can be admitted to public and private hospitals. Students must pay upfront medical expenses and provide the following documents for insurance purposes:

- 2. The actual receipt
- 3. Medical certificate

Academic and Career Counseling helps students choose the courses and programs of study that are most suited to their own personal interests and ability. 

Shops and Services Bank Services on Campus



Government Savings Bank is open for students at the Thaiburi Building, the main hall with services as listed below:

- 3. Fee collection service for student Registration and Dormitory fees.
- 4. Receive an ATM card which can withdraw money from a different branch but not an ATM card that can withdraw money from other banks.

Banks in Thasala – Two banks are available in the TESCO shopping centre in Thasala, (Bangkok bank and SCB). Both of these banks are open from 10 am every day of the week (including weekends) and close at 7 pm.

Please note: The ability to use your credit/debit or travel card is limited; therefore you should carry Thai Baht (\$\mathbb{B}\$) in cash for small purchases. The ATM machines charges a fee, 20-40 \$\mathbb{B}\$, when using a credit/debit card (and you may be charged a second time from your home bank), therefore it is preferable to use your travel card and/or withdraw money directly from the bank.



Campus Post Office

Located in the main hall of Thaiburi Building and in front of the Division of Student Affairs.

Shop available on Walailak University campus

- 1. Minimart There are three minimarts on campus: Family Mart (Cho Pradu food center) and 7-Eleven (close to student dormitories and at the AD Building)
- 2. Laundry service (at Cho Pradu food center), however each dormitory has approximately seven washing machines and there are laundry services available outside campus on the road to Thasala
- 3. Stationary store



Shops in Thasala – TESCO Lotus is the main shopping centre and reasonably close to the university (6.5 km), TESCO's is combined supermarket/department store with a variety of shops in the centre including: banks, cosmetic shops, jewelers, stationary, KFC and food court. To get there travel towards Thasala, turn left at the main T junction and continue for approximately 1 km.



Festival of the Tenth Lunar Month The Tenth Lunar Month is a grand event of the province in Southern Thailand. This festival is held from the 1st waning-moon night to the 15th waning-moon night every September. It is held to pay respect to deceased ancestors. According to Buddhist beliefs, the dead who have many sins and were sent to hell to become a demon. The demons are allowed to come up to meet their relatives for 15 days in September, but must return to hell before sunrise of the 15th day. The living try to appease the spirits by taking food to temples to make merit. Beginning on the 13th day, people will go shopping for food to be given. The 14th day is spent preparing and decorating the food tray, and the 15th day is the actual merit-making day. The trays presented nowadays have elaborate designs but still retain traditional components. Contests to find the most beautiful tray are held.
