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PART II ACCEPTANCE LETTER APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

I agree and accept the following requirements:

Apply for a **Non-Immigrant Visa (Category "ED")** at a Royal Thai Embassy or a Royal Thai Consulate-General before traveling to Thailand.

Buy a **personal health insurance**. The cost of health insurance in Thailand varies from 6,000 to 10,000 baht or more, depending on your age and its package. In addition, Walailak University provides a group accident insurance to all students.

PART III ARRIVAL GUIDE

Meet the Center for International Affairs (CIA), located on the 2nd Floor of Cooperative Building, **within 24 hours of your arrival at Walailak University**. Please make an appointment interaffairs.wu@gmail.com

According to section 38 of the 1979 Immigration Act, the University, as a house owner, has to notify the local immigration authorities within 24 hours from the arrival time of the foreigner.

Live in a **shared room at on-campus dormitory** and pay for the **monthly electricity and water bills**.

Buy or rent a **vehicle such as bicycle, motorbike, or car**. Due to a huge area of Walailak University, we highly recommend you to have a vehicle.

Prepare the following expenses during your study at Walailak University;

- 1) **Cost of living**, approximately **6,000 - 10,000 baht a month**.
- 2) **Visa extension fee, 1,900 baht**, paid once a year to the Immigration Office.
- 3) **Expenses for your study materials** such as text books, research samples/materials, thesis book printing and binding, etc.
- 4) **Expenses for an issuance of certified document** from the Center for Educational Services such as transcript record, student verification certificate. It costs 50 baht per document.

PART IV PRE-ARRIVAL MEASUREMENT

Requirement:

- 1) Eligible countries/territories
First port of departure must be from eligible countries/Territories for at least 21 consecutive days before travelling to Thailand (Thai nationals and foreign nationals departing from Thailand to eligible countries/territories and back to Thailand are exempted for the 21 day requirement)
- 2) Vaccination
Fully vaccinates against COVID-19 with a vaccine approved by Thailand no less than 14 days before departure or have recovered from COVID-19 infection and received one dose of vaccination within 3 months after recovery.



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- 3) Must have insurance with minimum coverage of 50,000 USD (returning expats, submitting proof of minimum 50,000 USD medical coverage)
- 4) Must have a paid SHA+/AQ hotel reservation confirmation (including RT-PCR test fee)
- 5) Register on Thailand Pass www.tp.consular.go.th
- 6) Must get a COVID Test (RT-PCR only) 72 hrs.
