MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("Memorandum") is made this 26th day of November 2021

between

WALAILAK UNIVERSITY, a public university established under the laws of Thailand and having its address at Walailak University, 222 Thaiburi, Thasala District, Nakhon Si Thammarat, 80160 Thailand (hereinafter called as "**WU**") hereinafter referred to as FIRST PARTY.

and

UNIVERSITAS NEGERI YOGYAKARTA, a public university established under the laws of Indonesia and having its principal office at Jalan Colombo No.1, Karangmalang, Depok, Sleman, Yogyakarta 55281, Indonesia hereinafter called as "**UNY**") hereinafter referred to as SECOND PARTY.

In order to promote cooperation between Walailak University, Thailand and Universitas Negeri Yogyakarta, Indonesia, the following terms have agreed upon:

1. To the extent feasible, both universities will encourage direct contact and cooperation between their faculty members, departments and schools.
2. The two universities will endeavor to cooperate in education and research areas of mutual interest.
3. Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the following forms of cooperation will be pursued:
 - a. Exchange of scholars, teaching staff and students;
 - b. Facilitation of the study abroad and work experience for students in relevant fields of studies;
 - c. Research, workshops and seminars collaboration;
 - d. Exchange of academic materials, instructional technology, instructional media for learning, scientific publications and other relevant information; and
 - e. Other activities and programs in areas of mutual interest, benefiting both parties.

Themes of joint activities and the most appropriate way of utilizing the results achieved will be mutually consulted with and agreed upon by both parties. Agreements entered into/ by Walailak University may be subject to review and approval by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation, Thailand. Similarly, agreements entered into/ by Universitas Negeri Yogyakarta may be subject to review and approval by the Indonesian Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology.

Both parties understand that all financial arrangements are subject to negotiation and availability of funds.



Representatives of both universities are signatories in the hope of promoting mutual friendship and cooperation. The MoU will remain in effect of five (5) years and can be renewed before the expiration date by mutual consent in writing of the parties at least 90 (ninety) days.
