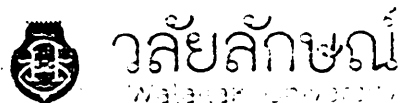


MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) (Hereafter “Memorandum”) entered into this day, June 9th of 2023 by and between **School of Allied Health Sciences, Walailak University, Thailand (SAH-WU)** where its address at 222 Thaiburi, Thasala District, Nakhon Si Thammarat 80160, Thailand and **College of Biomedical Science and Engineering, National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University, Taiwan (CBMSE-NYCU)** where its address at No. 155, Sec. 2, Linong St. Beitou Dist, Taipei City 112304, Taiwan

WHEREAS, both parties hereto desire to do so in order to promote exchange and cooperation in education, research, staff/student mobility, and social services as well as to foster and strengthen relationship between SAH-WU and CBMSE-NYCU.

AND WHEREAS:

- A. SAH-WU and CBMSE-NYCU agree to cooperate and broaden relationship and exchanges;
- B. SAH-WU and CBMSE-NYCU here to desire to give priorities to each other in the promotion and development of cooperation in areas of mutual benefits; and
- C. Both parties agree that all program activities to be carried out shall be based on mutual interest and advantages.

IT IS NOW AGREED AND RECOGNISED the following:

1. GENERAL AREAS OF CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 SAH-WU and CBMSE-NYCU agree that cooperation shall be carried out through activities of programs relating to, but not limited to, the following
 - 1. Education and research;
 - 2. Further training of staff;
 - 3. Exchange of scholarly materials and information;
 - 4. Organization and participation in international conference, seminars, symposia, short-term academic programs and academic meeting; and
 - 5. Any other fields related.
- 1.2 Any activities may be implemented, the parties shall discuss the relevant issues to the satisfaction of each party and enter into specific activity agreements based on the mutually agreed objectives and outcomes of the activity.
- 1.3 SAH-WU and CBMSE-NYCU shall each designate a coordinator to manage the program activities.

2. COST AND EXPENSES

Any cost and expenses incurred in performing any activity pursuant to this Memorandum such as training and advisory visits and staff attachments, etc. shall be negotiated to the mutual acceptance.

3. OWNERSHIP

Ownership on whatever products of studies/research shall belong to both parties of this Memorandum and no publication of the products of study of research is allowed to publish without the consent of both parties.

4. RALATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

No parts of this Memorandum are to be interpreted as neither party shall be an agent or a representative of the other party.

5. CONFIDENTIALITY

All information and or data that may be exchanged, acquired and shared in connection with the area of cooperation between SAH-WU and CBMSE-NYCU pursuant to this Memorandum shall be treated strictly confidential and shall not under any circumstances be divulged by the receiving party unless otherwise the said information and/or data have already been in the public domain.

6. GOVERNING LAW

This Memorandum shall be applied in accordance with the laws and regulations of the country of either party, where the activity is taking place.

7. NOTICES

Any notices, approval, application or any form of communication that is required to be given by each party under this Memorandum shall be in writing and shall be deem to be sufficiently served:

- (a) In the case of delivery by hand, on the day of delivery;
- (b) In the case of delivery by international express mail service, 15 business day after posting;
- (c) In the case of communication by email, when an email receipt is acknowledged by the recipient personally.

8. AMENDMENTS


This Memorandum may be amended or varied by mutual consent in writing with signature by duly authorized representatives of SAH-WU and CBMSE-NYCU. Such agreed amendments or variation shall be part of this Memorandum.

9. DURATION AND TERMINATION

- (a) This Memorandum shall enter into force on the last date of signature and shall remain in force for five (5) years unless terminated by the other party giving six (6) month notice to the other.
- (b) Where such termination occurs, the provision of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to on-going activities until their completion.
- (c) This Memorandum shall be reviewed at the end of five (5) years to determine the effectiveness to continue or terminate.
