

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

The Parties to the present MoU, having considered that they have common aims and interests in the field of teaching and research and that they wish to enhance academic cooperation in the framework of the higher education in both countries and worldwide and also in the interest of expanding educational opportunities and furthering of international understanding,

Have Agreed

To Sign a Memorandum of Understanding, hereinafter referred to as “MoU”, providing as follows:

The MoU is designed to facilitate and develop a genuine and mutually beneficial exchange and collaboration. Both parties hereby agree to encourage exchange and collaboration, as appropriate between their departments, research institutions, faculty and staff. In this joint program, both parties will be guided by their mutual interest in promoting development of scholarly and cultural cooperation between their respective institutions.

The **WALAILAK UNIVERSITY** and **UNIVERSITY OF MALAHAYATI** actually encourage to the exchange of contacts and information to facilitate the following activities:

1. Visit by and exchange of faculty and staff for academics, research, and extension;
2. Development of joint research, developmental and innovation activities;
3. Visit by and exchange of students for study, research, and extension;
4. Joint organization and conduct of conference, research project, workshops and symposium, etc.;
5. Provision of the link to the website of the other on their home page by both institutions;
6. Sharing of best practices in laboratory facilities, assignments, projects, and administration;
7. Curricula for diploma, undergraduate, and post-graduate programs;
8. Practical training, related learning experience and programmes of integrated knowledge;
9. Short courses and special short term academic programmes;
10. Sharing of teaching/instructional materials, information, and learning resources;
11. Other activities and programmes as mutually agreed upon by both Institutions.

As specific academic exchanges and collaborative activities are identified and agreed to by the two institutions, the term of mutual assistance and necessary budget for each program and the activity that is implemented and other specific details of these activities shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon, in writing, by both parties, prior to the intimation of the particular program or activity. Such programs and activities shall be negotiated in a timely manner. Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be separately negotiated and will depend on availability of resources. Any exchange of students and faculty members must be approved by the host institution in advance. Transfer of coursework credit must be secured in advance by the student at his/her home institutions.

This MoU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by informing the other through written notice six month in advance. In the event of termination, the provisions of this agreement shall continue to apply to on-going programmes until their completion. This MoU may be amended by the exchange of letters between the two institutions. Any amendments or notification require written approval by authorized signatories of each institution and shall be appended hereto. Such amendment once approved by both institutions, will be part of this MoU.

The Parties, by the signature of their authorized representatives, acknowledge having read and understood this MoU and agree to be bound by its terms and conditions.

The MoU has been executed by the legally authorized representatives of the said parties, two identical copies, all in English, of which the parties have taken one each.




