MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

WALAILAK UNIVERSITY (address: 222 Thaiburi, Thasala District, Nakhon Si Thammarat 60160, represented by Professor Dr. SOMBAT THAMRONGTHANYAWONG, PRESIDENT, hereinafter referred to as "WU", and Liaoning Normal University (address: 850 Huanghe Road, Dalian, China, represented by Professor. Dr. JIANG FENGCHUN, RECTOR, hereinafter referred to as "LNU", wishing to enhance relations between the two universities and to develop academic and cultural exchange in the area of education and other activities, have agreed to the following:

Article 1:

The Parties increase their academic, scientific and cultural relations within the field of education, training, research and administrative community services.

Article 2:

The Parties agree that their cooperation may include but not be limited to the following areas:

- 1) Exchange of researchers
- 2) Exchange of faculty
- 3) Exchange of students
- 4) Transfer of students
- 5) Exchange of staff members
- 6) Summer School
- 7) Exchange of scholarly and pedagogical materials
- 8) Joint research/programs
- 9) Technical assistance and/or training
- 10) Other cooperative efforts as may be specified later

Article 3:

The establishment of the cooperation of the Parties, the programmes and activities, their objectives, costs and achievements should be specified and approved in separated agreements that should include the general description of the activities, the staff involved, the duration of the specific programme and

the financial arrangements and the agreement on intellectual property rights for its implementation. The Parties agree that no obligation (especially, but not limited to the obligation to fund any activity, project or program under the scope of this MoU) may rise from this MoU, unless otherwise specified in a separate, written agreement of the Parties.

Article 4:

The Parties agree that all specific arrangements and plans for activities are to be negotiated and depend on the availability of funds. The Parties will seek funding for the activities defined in this MoU from various sources.

Article 5

Any notice to be issued under this MoU shall be in writing to the addresses and recipients listed above. It shall be deemed to have been served when personally delivered or, if transmitted by fax, electronic or digital transmission, when transmitted, provided that such transmission is confirmed by receipt of a successful transmission report and confirmed by mail.

Article 6:

The present MoU enters into force on the day when both Parties have signed it, and will remain in force for five (5) years. Both Parties may terminate this MoU with a six (6) month's prior written notice.

This MoU may be amended or modified at any time by mutual consent in writing by both Parties.

Article 7:

WU and LNNU shall abide by the policy of equal opportunity in the administration of this MoU and neither institution shall impose criteria for the exchange of scholars or students, which would violate the principles of non-discrimination.

Article 8:

This MoU is written in Chinese and English with the same legal effect, and held by each of the two Parties.

The Parties have signed the present MoU as being consistent with their will and consent.
