



**Memorandum of Agreement  
Between  
International College of Dentistry, Walailak University, Thailand  
and  
School of Stomatology, Kunming Medical University, P.R. China**

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is hereby designed and established between Walailak University International College of Dentistry (WUICD) and the School of Stomatology, Kunming Medical University, P.R. China on Thursday 29 August 2024. This agreement sets forth the specific terms and conditions governing the academic and professional collaboration between the two institutions:

**1. Student Exchange**

**1.1 Duration of Stay**

Duration of stay for undergraduate students of both universities shall be no more than 2 weeks/visit.

**1.2 Enrollment of Exchange Students**

1.2.1 Students of School of Stomatology, Kunming Medical University will be registered as special audit students, postgraduate or special research students at Walailak University and can attend lectures, seminars, clinics, field work and tutorials.

1.2.2. Students of Walailak University International College of Dentistry, Walailak University will be registered as audit students at Kunming Medical University and can attend lectures, seminars, clinics, field work and tutorials.

1.2.3 Participating students will be subjected to the regulations of the host school.

**1.3 Selection of Exchange Students**

Both institutions agree to select students for exchange based on the availability of a suitable academic curriculum and the host institution's capacity to provide an appropriate academic advisor for the students' major field of study. This ensures that the selected students will receive relevant academic guidance and support during their elective period.

**1.4 Academic Record and Accreditation**

Exchange students shall submit their academic records, transcripts, diplomas, or equivalent documentation obtained from the host institution to their home institution. The home institution will review and accredit these records in accordance with its own academic policies and regulations.

## 1.5 Financial Arrangement

1.5.1 Each student shall be exempt from payment of the entrance examination fee, admission fee and tuition fee based on reciprocity of the host school.

1.5.2 The visiting institution shall be responsible for arranging and providing accommodation for their students during the elective period. Additionally, the visiting institution shall arrange and cover all necessary ground transportation for their students, including transportation between the airport and the designated accommodation at the beginning and conclusion of the elective period.

1.5.3 Exchange students will be responsible for their own expenses including those for international travel, health insurance and meals.

## 2. Staff exchange

The staff under the exchange programs is expected to study and work according to their own plan for professional improvement and research and to the mutually agreed purpose of the exchange. Visiting staff may be authorized to teach regularly scheduled classes and seminars during each academic term at the host school in the area of their expertise.

## 3. Research collaboration

Both Parties agree to work towards the establishment of mutual cooperation for common research and to undertake joint research projects as mutually agreed upon well as to identify and provide, upon request, contact person for specified program activities.

## 4. Development of joint program


Both Parties agree to work towards the development of joint program and the articulation of various academic credits for programs/courses, which entitles the students to complete a part of the program of study at each school and be awarded the degree upon completion of formalities.

## 5. Duration

This MOU will remain in effect for five (5) years from the date of signing, and is renewable thereafter for further five-year terms subject to mutual consent. This MOU may be terminated by either school at any time by providing the other school with a ninety (90) days' notice (in writing) of the intent to terminate.

## 6. Language of this memorandum

Memorandum will be written in English, and each school will keep one copy.
