

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
SCHOOL OF ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES, WALAILAK UNIVERSITY, THAILAND
AND
SCHOOL OF ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES, KITASATO UNIVERSITY, JAPAN**

Preamble: School of Allied Health Sciences, Walailak University (WU), Thailand, and School of Allied Health Sciences, Kitasato University (KU), Japan, hereby agree to promote bilateral student training collaboration.

Scope of Cooperation: The two parties agree on the following student training cooperation activities:

- i. **Student Training Program:** Undergraduate students conduct education training and cultural exchange approved by the host faculty member/supervisor.
- ii. **Visiting Period:** The duration of the program shall last from 2 weeks to 3 months, with credits transferred to the home university. Upon completion, the students shall return to their home university.
- iii. **Participant Limit:** 2 students per year, adjustable with consent.
- iv. **Eligibility:** The 3rd or 4th year undergraduates of study at the home university.
- v. **Research Facilities:** Students may use host university labs for education training under the supervision of the host faculty member/supervisor.
- vi. **Accommodation:** Depending on availability, the host university agrees to facilitate or suggest accommodation for the visiting faculty/student.

Financial Responsibilities

Tuition fees for the training program will be bilaterally waived for participating students. Each home institution will bear all other expenses related to this collaboration.

Intellectual Property

Each university will adhere to its nation's intellectual property laws. Any information received under non-disclosure agreements will be protected accordingly.

Relationship

The arrangement is on a principal-to-principal basis, excluding joint venture, agency, partnership, or similar relationships. Neither party shall act on behalf of the other.

Legal Status

This agreement fosters cooperation without legal binding. Disputes will be resolved through mutual discussion.

Validity

This agreement is valid for five (5) years from the date of signing by both universities and can be extended by mutual consent. Termination requires six months' prior notice. Previous commitments remain honored.

Note: Specific programs may require separate agreements detailed as annexures.
