



## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

**THIS MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT** is between

**UNIVERSITAS BRAWIJAYA** acting through its Faculty of Medicine of Jalan Veteran, Malang, East Java 65145, INDONESIA

**(UB)**

**AND**

**WALAILAK UNIVERSITY** acting through its School of Medicine of 222 Thaiburi, Thasala District, Nakhon Si Thammarat 80160, THAILAND

**(WU)**

UB and WU may use the following protocols to govern their collaboration on academic and research-related activities in medicine and health sciences.

### **Scope**

The scope of collaboration on academic and research activities included in this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) includes, but not limited to, the following categories:

1. Research collaboration;
2. Joint supervision;
3. Staff mobility programs;
4. Undergraduate student exchange program;
5. Cooperative seminars, workshops, and other academic activities; and
6. Other collaborative activities based on mutual interest.

### **Implementation**

To implement this MOA, the following is mutually understood:

1. Proposals for collaborative work under this MOA will be submitted for approval through the normal procedures of each party.
2. The final approval of any activity will depend on the availability of the guaranteed support funds.
3. Each party is liable for its own acts and omissions under this MOA, including for the prevention of doubt or any liability to a third party arising from its acts or omissions.

### **Non-binding**

This MOA is not intended by the parties to be legally binding and nothing in this MOA prevents either party from entering collaborative arrangements with other organizations covering the same subject matter.

### Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

1. This MOA is effective as of the date of signing by the appropriate officer of the last party to sign.
2. This MOA shall remain in force for a period of **two (2) years** from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated earlier by either party giving at least six months' notice to the other party in writing.
3. The MOA may be amended or extended by mutual consent in writing of the two parties.
4. If this MOA were translated into another language, both texts would be authentic, but the English text would prevail in the event of a dispute.

### Counterparts and Electronic Communications

This MOA may be executed in counterparts, which taken together will constitute one document. Counterparts may be exchanged by digital scan which may be relied upon by the receiving party as having the same legal force and effect as the original signed counterpart.


