



AGREEMENT
FOR
SCHOLARLY EXCHANGE AND COLLABORATION BETWEEN
THE WALAILAK UNIVERSITY
AND
THE TOKYO UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY

In recognition of common interests shared and as an expression of the desire to expand and strengthen the relationships between the two institutions, the WALAILAK UNIVERSITY and the TOKYO UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY agree to extend the program of academic exchange for the period from June 1, 2024 through May 31, 2029.

The WALAILAK UNIVERSITY (hereinafter referred to as "WU") and the TOKYO UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY (hereinafter referred to as "TUAT") will endeavor to promote academic exchange activities of mutual benefit. These activities are further described within the Memorandum of Understanding.

Exchange of Faculty Members

Faculty members will be exchanged in the field of natural sciences, agriculture, engineering and other fields which each institution desires to encourage.

The number of faculty members to be exchanged will be determined each year by mutual agreement between the two institutions.

The nomination process will acknowledge the academic interests of the sending (home) institution and research and scholarly interests of individual faculty participants.

Exchange of Students

WU and TUAT may nominate undergraduate and graduate students for study programs as non-degree exchange students. The host institution will consider these applications in accordance with its standard practice for admission of exchange students.

The number of students to be exchanged will be determined each year by mutual agreement.

Joint Research and Other Scholarly Activities

WU and TUAT agree to encourage joint research and other scholarly ventures by members of faculty and staff. Since such joint activities will be unique, each proposal will be evaluated and executed on an individual basis.

Exchange of Publications


WU and TUAT agree to exchange, on a regular basis, publications as agreed and specified by each institution. These publications may include catalogs, serials, and other library materials.

Extension/Evaluation

This agreement will remain in force through May 31, 2029. During 2028-2029, this exchange will be reviewed by the responsible committee at each institution. Major revision or cancellation of this agreement must be proposed in official writing to the other party. In the event of such major revision or cancellation, the host institution will provide current participants with the opportunity to complete their approved program.

Two copies will be made of this agreement and both sides (parties) have one copy.


