MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between
WALAILAK UNIVERSITY
and
COLLEGE OF PROFESSIONAL AND CONTINUING EDUCATION LIMITED

(individually referred to as “party”, and collectively referred to as “parties”)

College of Professional and Continuing Education Limited (“CPCE”) having its principal office at 9 Hoi Ting Road, Yau Ma Tei, Kowloon, Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People’s Republic of China, and Walailak University (“WU”) having its principal office at 222 Thaiburi, Thasala, Nakhon Si Thammarat, Thailand, considering their common interest in promoting the mutual collaboration in the area of education and research, have set forth the following Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”):

1. Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to develop academic and educational collaborations on the basis of equality and reciprocity and to promote relations and mutual understanding between CPCE and WU. This MOU will cover partnership with Walailak University (“WU”).

(CPCE is a self-financed subsidiary of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (“PolyU”). CPCE and its constituent units are managed by its management and College Council.)

2. Scope of Cooperation

Both parties undertake to promote and develop academic collaborations which include but are not limited to the following:

- Exchange of academic staff and students;
- Collaboration in research and the promotion of research outputs;
- Joint participation in internationally funded projects; and
- Joint extra-curricular activities for students of both parties.

3. Arrangements of Implementation

- i. A detailed description of the collaboration, including financial arrangements, will be developed mutually for each specific case that will be subject to the review and approval processes of both parties.
- ii. The parties will ensure that all public statements including statements to the media or articles relating to the collaboration are cleared and consented by both prior to release or publication.

- iii. Neither party shall use the name or logo of the other party for any purpose whether in relation to any advertisement or other form of publicity without obtaining the prior written consent of the other party.
- iv. Both parties will evaluate the collaboration on a yearly basis.
- v. Both parties agree to designate the following persons as the local representatives for the coordination of the collaboration:
 - a. For CPCE: Dr. Pimtong Tavitiyaman
 - b. For WU: Assoc. Prof. Dr. Surin Maisrikord

4. Duration of MOU

This MOU will be effective upon signatures by both parties. It will be in force for five years and may be revised and/or renewed upon mutual written consent. Either party may terminate this MOU by giving a six-month prior written notice to the other party. Such termination shall not affect the validity and continuity of any incompletely discharged obligation agreed upon by the two parties before termination.

5. Exclusion of Third Party Rights




