

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Walailak University International College of Dentistry and

Ulm University School of Dentistry

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is to develop academic and educational cooperation on the basis of equality and reciprocity and to promote sustainable partnership and mutual understanding between the Walailak University International College of Dentistry in Thailand and Ulm University School of Dentistry in Germany, hereinafter referred to as the "parties".

This MoU is not meant to establish a legal or financial relationship between the parties, but rather a statement of intent to foster the possibility of true and mutually beneficial collaboration.

1. Areas of collaboration

Collaboration is sought in the following areas

- research, including academic visits, the exchange of information, scientific materials or researchers, and/or the development of collaborative research projects
- education, including the exchange of teaching or administrative staff, academic materials, and/or the organization of joint academic activities such as lectures, seminars, conferences and courses
- short term students exchange programs
- others

2. Scope of the memorandum

This MoU is non-binding with the intention of facilitating collaboration between the participating institutions. The execution of any specific collaboration decided upon by both parties shall be subject to separate written agreements. Each separate agreement shall contain all major details of the execution of the collaboration. If a research cooperation is sought, the written agreement should clarify the following, among others:

- financial provisions;
- delegation/exchange of staff;
- warranty and liability;
- user rights of patentable and non-patentable results of work;
- confidentiality and use of information;
- publication rights,
- export control obligations, including embargos and sanctions

The parties agree that nothing in this MoU shall be construed as a license or transfer or an obligation to enter into any further agreement with respect to any intellectual property currently licensed to or belonging to either party.

Any transfer of intellectual property, inventions or innovations must be negotiated in specific agreements.

All intellectual property held by a party will remain the property of the party introducing or disclosing it.

3. Costs

Except when otherwise specifically agreed in writing, all costs resulting from cooperation will be borne by the party that incurs them. Whenever a delegation / exchange of staff is contemplated under this MoU, the sending party will be responsible for the salaries, insurance, benefits, travel expenses and allowances to be paid to its personnel.

4. General Provisions

This MoU shall commence on the date of its signing by the parties and remain in force for five (5) years unless either party gives at least six (6) months' written notice to terminate the MoU. It may be amended or modified by the parties' written mutual consent.

An extension after the first five years should be considered if the intentions for cooperation between the two parties have been renewed.

Either party may terminate this MoU by giving the other party a six (6) months' notice in writing.
