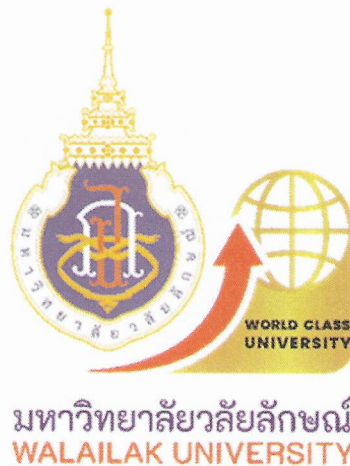

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

WALAILAK UNIVERSITY
and

WIRTSCHAFTSVERBAND WESTFALEN-LIPPE E.V.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made between **Walailak University**, located at 222 Thaiburi, Tha Sala District, Nakhon Si Thammarat 80160, Thailand, and **[Partner University]**, located at [address], [country].

Walailak University and [Partner University] are hereinafter referred to collectively as **"the Parties"** and individually as **"a Party."**

The Parties share a common interest in promoting academic cooperation and strengthening collaboration in **research, teaching, learning, and/or other academic activities.**

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Memorandum is to establish a framework for cooperation between the Parties and to promote academic collaboration of mutual interest.

2. GENERAL CO-OPERATION FRAMEWORK

- 1.1. Walailak University and WIRTSCHAFTSVERBAND WESTFALEN-LIPPE E.V. (WWL) agree that they intend to promote cooperation through such activities and/or programs as mentioned in clause 3 of this Memorandum.
- 1.2. Both Parties acknowledge that programs and activities enumerated are not exhaustive and the Parties may agree to include such other programs and activities as may be mutually acceptable and identified later after mutual discussion and agreement in writing by both Parties prior to the

initiation of the particular program or activity and such shall be negotiated as required.

- 1.3. Walailak University and WIRTSCHAFTSVERBAND WESTFALEN-LIPPE E.V. (WWL), within their respective financial, technical and educational capacities, cooperate to promote and develop programs relating to health science, science and technology and social science.

3. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

WALAILAK UNIVERSITY (WU) and WIRTSCHAFTSVERBAND WESTFALEN-LIPPE E.V. (WWL) agree and acknowledge that collaboration may cooperate in areas including, but not limited to::

WALAILAK UNIVERSITY

- 3.1 **Research Collaboration** – Opportunities for postgraduate research placements for Walailak University staff within the German Entrepreneurial Network.
- 3.2 **Student Mobility** – Internship opportunities of approximately eight (8) months within the German Entrepreneurial Network for Walailak University students who possess at least B2-level proficiency in English or German.
- 3.3 **Career Opportunities** – Promotion of job opportunities within the German Entrepreneurial Network to graduates from the School of Nursing, School of Engineering and Technology, and other health science-related schools at Walailak University, as well as graduates from other Thai universities.

WIRTSCHAFTSVERBAND WESTFALEN-LIPPE E.V. (WWL)

- 3.4 **German Language Support** – Provision or facilitation of German language instructors by WWL to support the development of German language proficiency among Walailak University students.
- 3.5 **Industry–University Engagement** – Facilitation by WWL of collaboration between German entrepreneurs and Walailak University, particularly the **School of Nursing and the School of Engineering and Technology**, through activities such as industry talks, mentorship, applied learning projects, guest lectures, and co-curricular skill development initiatives. These engagements aim to provide students with practical industry insights and entrepreneurial exposure during their academic studies and to prepare them for internships or employment opportunities in Germany.

4. IMPLEMENTATION

All collaborative activities under this MoU shall be carried out subject to the availability of resources and applicable regulations of each Party.

Each Party shall designate a contact person to coordinate activities related to this MoU.

5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Ownership of intellectual property resulting from any collaborative activity shall be determined by **mutual agreement in writing between the Parties prior to the commencement of the specific activity.**

6. CONFIDENTIALITY

Each Party shall respect the confidentiality of any information shared in connection with activities under this MoU and shall not disclose such information without the prior written consent of the other Party, unless required by law.

7. RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES

This MoU does not create a legal partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship between the Parties. Each Party remains independent and responsible for its own activities.

8. AMENDMENTS

This MoU may be amended at any time by mutual written agreement of the Parties. Any amendments shall become part of this MoU once signed by authorized representatives of both Parties.

9. EFFECTIVE DATE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

- a) This MoU shall become effective on the date of the **last signature** by the Parties.
- b) This MoU shall remain valid for a period of **five (5) years**, unless terminated earlier by either Party.
- c) Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing **ninety (90) days' written notice** to the other Party. Any ongoing activities shall be completed unless otherwise mutually agreed.

10. GOVERNING LAW

Activities conducted under this MoU shall comply with the **laws and**

regulations of the country in which the activities take place.

11. NOTICES

Any notice or communication related to this MoU shall be made in writing and sent to the designated representatives of the Parties.

Notices shall be deemed received:

- On the date of delivery if delivered by hand
- Fifteen (15) business days after posting if sent by registered mail
- If sent by email, when the receiving Party acknowledges receipt. If no acknowledgment is received within fifteen (15) days, the notice shall be deemed duly received.

11. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, **each Party shall bear its own costs** related to activities conducted under this MoU.

12. NON-BINDING NATURE

This MoU reflects the intentions of the Parties to cooperate and does **not constitute a legally binding agreement**, except where specific provisions are stated otherwise in separate written agreements.

13. PUBLIC STATEMENTS AND USE OF NAME

Neither Party shall use the **name, logo, or trademarks** of the other Party in publications or public communications without prior written consent.

14. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

Each Party shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations in its jurisdiction, including those relating to education, immigration, data protection, and export control.

15. ENTIRE UNDERSTANDING

This MoU represents the entire understanding between the Parties regarding the subject matter and supersedes any previous discussions or understandings.
